Zo Tum Hmung is the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Burma Research Institute (formerly known as the Chin Association of Maryland, Inc.). He previously co-founded and served as the Executive Director of the Ethnic Nationalities Affairs Center-Union of Burma (ENAC), a research center that supports the peace process and development of democratic institutions in Burma. Mr. Hmung completed his Master in
